
MUG is one of the oldest medical universities in Poland


- MUG is the largest medical university in northern Poland








6-YEAR M.D. PROGRAMME

- Available for candidates from all over the world
- Apply via MUG or proper recruitment companies depending on citizenship
- The extended curriculum is based on strict European and US standards.
 Upon graduation, students receive a diploma of M.D. and can apply for a license to practice medicine





5,5-YEAR PHARMACY PROGRAMME

- Available for candidates from all over the world
- Apply via MUG or proper recruitment company
- Curriculum based on strict European and US standards
- The 11-semester Pharmacy Programme, including 6-months pre-registration training in an approved pharmacy leads to the degree of Master of Pharmacy and allows for registration as a pharmacist in Poland
- The Polish registration is recognised in other EU member states





3-YEAR BACHELOR OF NURSING PROGRAMME

- Available for candidates from all over the world
- Modern Nursing Skills Lab with special equipment and teaching aid such as manikins
- Graduates will be prepared to practice nursing independently all of the world
- Curriculum based on strict European and US standards







1-YEAR PREMEDICAL COURSE

- Available for high school graduates and especially for applicants who haven't been accepted for 6year M.D. Programme
- Meets the needs of high school graduates who wish to pursue medical education, but who have taken few or none of the science courses required for successful admission to medical school
- Lasts from the beginning of October to the end of May and is divided into 2 semesters
- All classes are conducted in English
- Graduates have the opportunity to be accepted for the 6-year M.D. Programme at the MUG in next academic year







- Special week of orientation activities and courses for all freshman students and incoming ERASMUS+ students
- Introduces students to medical university realities and formally inducts them into the chosen medical professions
- Major activities include Welcome and Overview, Social Events, Distribution of Student ID Cards, Polish Language Course, Matriculation Ceremony, Student Resources, Stress Management/Mental Health information



- A pioneering pancreatic islets transplantation






UNIVERSITY CLINICAL CENTRE

Latest achievements – 2019

- 1st in Poland and one of the few in the world atrial cardiac flow regulator implantation (January 2019)
- First use of mechanical thrombectomy in child stroke therapy in Poland (February 2019)







INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

- MUG cooperates with many centers in Europe and the world, i.e. as part of intercollegiate and intergovernmental agreements, thematic networks, membership in international organisations or science conferences and symposiums (nearly 800 institutions from Europe and over 200 institutions from USA)
- Interinstitutional cooperation with 34 universities and institutes
- MUG is a member of: Baltic Sea Region University Network, ScanBalt, EUPRIO, Study in Poland, Study in Pomorskie





- Since 1998 the University has actively participated in the Erasmus+ (previously SOCRATES/Erasmus Programme)
- Each year a growing number of our students are sent to 50 partner universities in the EU
- The University accepts an increasing number of international students, who complete part of their studies at MUG in English



INTERNATIONAL GUEST STUDENTS

- Opportunity to study medicine for 1 to at most
 2 semesters at MUG without being part of a specific exchange programme and on a payment basis
- Guests students receive a Transcripts of Records
- There is no degree granted to those students
- In order to become a guest student, an international student has to undertake courses of at least 10 ECTS/semester
- All courses are fully taught in English



- Project leaders prof. Arkadiusz Piotrowski (MUG) and prof. Jan Dumański (Uppsala University)








CARDIAC SIMULATION LABORATORY
